You are a PhD student at the Université de Lorraine and you would like to do a research stay abroad?

Apply for DrEAM!

DrEAM is the program set up by the Université de Lorraine within the framework of the Lorraine Université d'Excellence Initiative (LUE) to finance the international mobility of its PhD students within a research unit abroad. It is open to all PhD students enrolled at the Université de Lorraine.



Eligibility criteria

- The mobility must take place within the framework of a structured research partnership or one in the process of being structured.
- The PhD student must be hosted in an academic research structure (excluding companies).
- The grant must concern mobility projects lasting from 2 to 6 months, which may be divided into several stays of at least 2 months as part of an overall project.
- The PhD student must be enrolled in a doctoral program at the Université de Lorraine and travel during the 36 months following the first registration in full-time PhD or the 72 months following the first registration in part-time PhD.
- If the PhD student is doing an international joint PhD (cotutelle), he/she must carry out his/her research stay in a country different from the cotutelle partner country.
- The thesis supervisor, the head of research unit and the head of doctoral school, as well as the PhD student's employer if different from the Université de Lorraine, must be in favour of this mobility.

Funding modalities

The international mobility grant includes:

- Financial support for a round trip to the host structure abroad for a maximum amount of €1,500, based on the economic rate. If the stay is split, only one round trip will be covered.
- A travel allowance package which may not exceed €5,000. This package covers part of the living expenses in the host country. It includes daily allowances (meals and accommodation) and ancillary expenses (public transport, visas, etc.).

Required documents

- Complete application form with the previsional schedule of the research activities and tasks planned during the stay
- Detailed CV of maximum 2 pages including produced publications and posters
- Letter of acceptance from the host institution stating the dates of stay
- Quotations for accommodation and transport expenses to the host institution

You must upload each document to the dedicated space on the home page of your ADUM personal account.
